Subject: Questions to be asked at January 2019 board meeting

Brenda Leigh:

In the Mirror there ran an article on Nov 28 stating that the residents of Cortes Island must accept further delays regarding our referendum because you have "heard concerns from concerned citizens via E-mail. "

Why were these Emails sent to you, who does not represent Cortes?

Why have they not been forwarded to Director Anderson and the rest of the board?

Why have they been not made public and entered into the record?

How many E-mails have you received and from how many individuals?

How long has this been going on?

We do not require to know the identities of the people who sent the E-mails, it's not important, but we demand that you release this information! We need to know if the information is accurate and made in good faith since it appears to have influenced decisions made on our behalf.

Will you now honor the wishes of the people as expressed in the referendum without further delay? We were led to believe that that the next referendum would quickly follow the first, but still, we wait.

Director Anderson has been served, as you are aware, with a charge of taking bribes from her friends during a family emergency in return for political favors. You will recognize some of the names on the petition as longtime opponents of Director Anderson. Note that by implication her friends stand accused also of offering bribes. I honestly can't believe people that I know can be that cruel. It appears now that you have hired a private investigator to look into the matter, he came to our house with many questions.
